

## **Safety Guidelines for The Historic Asolo Theater and Benfer Courtyard**

The Historic Asolo Theater (HAT) at The John and Mable Ringling Museum of Art is excited to be able to offer extraordinary experiences showcasing live performance, film, artist talks, scholar lectures and masterclasses to our patrons. The health and safety of both our patrons and our staff is of the utmost importance and thus, we invite you to familiarize yourself with our guidelines:

Face masks covering the mouth and the nose are required for all audience members, both inside the HAT and in the Benfer Courtyard. Face coverings must be left in place throughout the entire performance.

Capacity for the HAT has been set at 50 people.

Please do not come to theater if you are feeling ill.

Everyone must maintain a six-foot distance from anyone not in their party at all times. All related parties will be seated a minimum of 6 feet away from other parties.

Our HVAC systems are regularly maintained, and we have installed UV air purifiers throughout these systems in all of our facilities.

All areas of the theater, visitors pavilion and museum are regularly cleaned and sanitized, with special attention to high-touch, high-traffic areas.

To promote a touchless experience, our season playbills and other programming information are available electronically on our website for download, and sent via email to ticket holders. Information will also be displayed on large screens at the venue.

The Ringling reserves the right to require a patron to leave if they do not abide by the mask rule and other safety rules noted above.

### **Policies that Apply to Museum Admission**

Visitors are required to wear masks when inside venues and to practice proper social distancing. When outdoors, masks are encouraged when social distancing isn't possible. Please note: visitors participating a Bayfront Garden Tour are required to wear masks.

Visitors are encouraged to purchase tickets online, prior to arrival.

All groups are limited to 10 persons or less while inside any building, and venue occupancy is limited to comply with social distancing guidelines.

Trams will operate only for persons with limited mobility.

The hands-on Tibbals Interactive Galleries in the Circus Museum and the Art Library remain closed.
